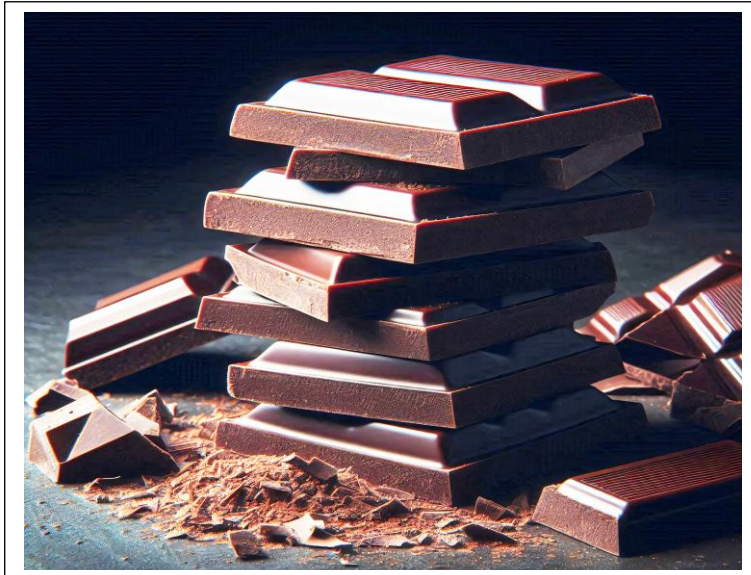




The Development of Chocolate

Antiques



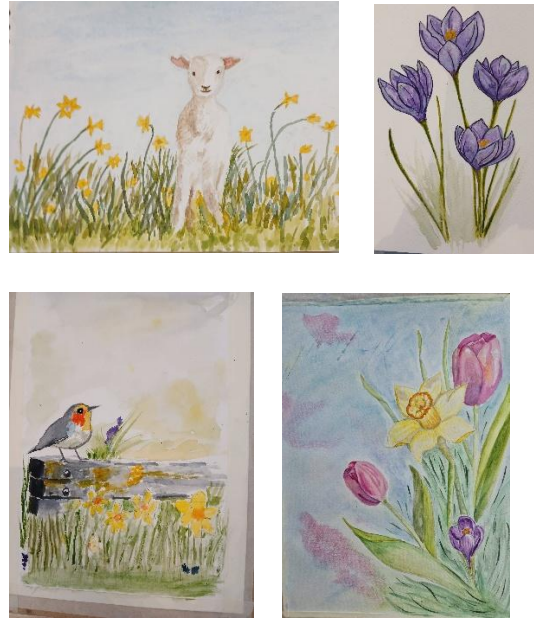
The group enjoyed a talk about the very fine Belleek pottery from Northern Ireland.
